On January 15, 2016, the Rock County Homeless Intervention Task Force held its annual prioritization meeting at the Rock County Job Center. This meeting consisted of service providers, public officials/elected representatives and agency participants.

The meeting began with participants sharing their stories and experiences with the group. The individuals that shared their stories were able to speak about how they got connected with an agency or multiple agencies and the barriers they have been able to overcome. Once everyone that wanted to share their stories had finished, everyone was asked to vote on which services they felt were priority for funding in the 2016 year.

Each participant and public official/elected representative received 3 votes per person. Each agency received 3 votes for the whole agency, not per employee. The results of the voting for each group are listed above.

The top three priorities for this year are emergency shelter, mental health services and AODA treatment. According to the participants their top three priorities are security deposit/one month assistance, multiple month rental assistance and emergency shelter. One participant pointed out that while mental health and AODA treatment is very important, people are not able to focus on getting their mental health and/or addictions stable when they are worried about where they are going to sleep at night.
